

Disaster SNAP (Food Stamps) Can Provide You With Temporary Food Assistance: Apply December 12-18, 2012

* Available to households that would not ordinarily be eligible for SNAP benefits

You do not have to be a citizen or legal permanent resident to qualify!

* If you lived in the following areas on October 27, 2012 you may be eligible to apply:

*To qualify, your household must fit into the following monthly income guidelines:

2	\$2,965	\$367
3	\$3,416	\$526
4	\$4,034	\$668
5	\$4,452	\$793
6	\$4,979	\$952
Each Additional Person	+ \$384	+ \$150

*Disaster gross income limit = net monthly income + cash on hand + checking and savings accounts

*Bring **proof** of identity and residency as of October 27, 2012, income, resources, family composition and disaster-related expenses from October 27-November 25, such as home or car damage, hotel expenses, etc. Loss of food is not counted as a disaster-related expense.

* You must apply in person or with a representative at one of the following two locations:
